CALCINED CLAY TOPDRESSING FOR INFIELDS

PRESEASON INFIELD PREP

- Ensure infield skin has been properly graded and compacted for positive run off.
- 2. Apply FairBall topdressing to your infield according to the *Usage Table* below based on your infield size and the depth of topdressing. Do not maintain more than 1/4" of topdressing on the surface of your infield skin.
- Scarify or nail drag FairBall topdressing into top 1/4". Do not till as an amendment.
- 4. Finish drag for consistent coverage across infield skin.
- Call 866-867-0052 with questions and more recommendations.

IN-SEASON DAILY MAINTENANCE

- Maintain 1/4" coverage of FairBall Topdressing on top surface. Add more as needed to maintain depth.
- Saturate thoroughly with water between games and after last game, if possible.
- 3. Light nail drag in morning with proper moisture.
- 4. Finish mat drag and maintain even moisture until game time.

▶ WET FIELD CONDITIONS

- Apply FairBall topdressing to wet areas and allow topdressing to absorb excess moisture.
- 2. Rake or drag smooth.
- 3. Remove excess the next day if topdressing exceeds 1/2".
