BLACKSTICK IS READY TO GO RIGHT OUT OF THE BAG...



Excavate area to a three-inch depth.



Apply BlackStick mound clay to area.



Rake to match grade then fully compact until firm.



Lightly water between lifts. Add clay if low, cut down if high, compact. Lightly water, cover with infield mix or topdressing.
